Yes. At least one component of the Central Oregon Coast Fire and Rescue action plan has been finalized and updated within the required timeframe of **2021 through May 26, 2026**.

The department's **Vehicle Extrication Equipment and Training Action Plan** was developed and updated during the current planning cycle in 2026. The plan incorporates operational assessments, training feedback, and equipment evaluations conducted during recent extrication training with **Elite Extrication and Equipment**. This training provided updated guidance on modern extrication techniques, vehicle construction challenges, and equipment performance requirements, which were incorporated into the final version of the plan.

The action plan also reflects updated operational priorities related to motor vehicle collisions occurring along major transportation corridors within the district, including **U.S. Route 101** and **Oregon Route 34**. These updates ensure that the department's policies, training strategies, and equipment acquisition plans align with current roadway safety needs and modern emergency response standards.

In addition, the planning process included participation from department leadership, on-duty personnel, volunteer firefighters, and coordination with regional partners such as **Yachats Rural Fire Protection District**. Input from these stakeholders contributed to refining the action plan and ensuring that it reflects current operational conditions and mutual aid coordination requirements.

As a result, the finalized action plan meets the requirement of having been **developed and updated within the eligible timeframe (2021–May 26, 2026)** and reflects current operational practices, training initiatives, and equipment modernization goals for Central Oregon Coast Fire and Rescue.
